

Telephone Conversation- John WEEKS (Knox Head Master)

Brief Description: At 8.00am on Monday 02/03/2009, PCSC A CAMPBELL contacted John WEEKS the current Head Master at Knox Grammar via his mobile phone REDACTED in relation obtaining details when he attended Sex Crimes in Parramatta re Historical matters.

WEEKS contacted Graeme WILSON in relation to an Adult Pornography video he had in his possession. The video was the subject of an investigation involving Craig TRELOAR (a teacher at Knox Grammar) and investigator Stuart PEARSON in 1987.

At this time a student made a report to PEARSON that he was shown the Pornography by TRELOAR.

The video has been handed over to WEEKS by PEARSON. In August 2007 WEEKS has contacted WILSON in relation to the video and as result both WEEKS and WILSON have attended the ombudsmans office with it. WEEKS alleges that the Ombudsman's office have referred them to Police Sex Crimes Unit.

WEEKS and WILSON claim that in August 2007 they attended the Sex Crimes Squad in Parramatta and spoke with then Detective Sergeant Elizabeth CULLEN. WEEKS claims that D/S CULLEN took a report. During the conversation with D/S CULLEN, WEEKS claims that he has made comment in relation to the investigation involving Adrian NISBETT (Allegations of inappropriate behaviour) that he opened in 2004 when he become Head Master. WEEKS claims at this time D/S CULLEN informed him of operation Paradox involving a number of teachers at Knox Grammar that was being monitored.
