Dear Tim,

I am writing in response to your letter dated the 7th December 2001. I appreciate your update in relation to Northside Christian Centre inc.

I wrote to you on the 19th October 2001 (not the 9th October as indicated in your correspondence) that I had forwarded your correspondence to our insurers. To this point, I have not received any further information from the insurers.

In relation to your request for financial assistance from Northside, I am afraid that I am unable to help at this time. All churches within the Assemblies of God fellowship are autonomous and are responsible for their own affairs. Our National Office works on a relatively small budget and doesn't have excess funds available.
