The Board of Directors has resolved as follows:

- "1. That the Chairman gain further clarification regarding "Not notifying parents" where a case of child abuse is detected or reported and the potential conflict which may exist between the spiritual imperative and the State Mandate."
- "2. That the Principal seek further input from Christian Community Schools and any other competent source and keep the Board informed."
- "3. That the Principal explore the possibility of conducting Parent Seminars to inform them of the legislation and its implications."
- "4. That the Principal and College Council give attention to :
  - (a) incorporating mandatory reporting implications and requirements on parents as an essential part of any new or modified parent interview process;
  - (b) reviewing interview procedures to include:
    - Pastoral spiritual fitness
    - Principal academic/curriculum
    - Bursar fees and settlement
  - (c) ensuring that teachers are living examples to students - in word, in deed, in dress, in spirit and in discipline."

That the Principal report back to the Board on the above at the Board meeting of February 21st, 1995.
