3.5. Supervision Times and Yard Duty

That the arrangements as set out in the College Newsletter on the 12 November 1987, detailed below, be endorsed as Policy.

- 1) Although staff are at school at 8.15 for a prayer meeting, supervision of the yard does not commence until 8.30, which is 15 minutes before the start of classes. Any students at school before 8.30 are, then, unsupervised and are at their, or their parents, own risk.
- 2) Staff are rostered to supervise students leaving school from the car park until 3.40 p.m.

Any students not picked up by 3.40 p.m. will be required to return inside the school grounds and be picked up from there.

There are usually teachers still at school beyond 4.00 p.m.

3) Parents are requested to inform the school by phone or note, of any regular or unusual lateness in collecting students.

The office is open until 4.30 p.m. daily.

4) Please emphasize to your children that they should tell a teacher if they have not been collected at the normal time.

3.6. Disadvantaged Schools Program for 1988

The Principal reported that our D.S.P. Submission for 1988 has been approved in full. The total grant of \$10,332 includes \$8,582 for the employment of a .3 salary Technical Facilitator in the area of Audio-Visual, \$400 of Audio-Visual Software, and \$1,350 as a subsidy for students to attend the C.C.S. Bi-Centennial program in Sydney in March 1988.
