- 1. The defendant must not assault, molest, harass, threaten or otherwise interfere with the protected person(s).
- 13. Other Orders: A. SHALL NOT KNOWINGLY RESIDE AT OR ENTER ANY PREMISES AT WHICH ANY PERSON IN NEED OF PROTECTION MAY FROM TIME TO TIME RESIDE. B. SHALL NOT ENTER WITHIN THE GROUNDS OF THE SCHOOL KNOWN AS REDACTED  
SHALL NOT APPROACH OR CONTACT ANY PERSON IN NEED OF PROTECTION BY ANY MEANS (INCLUDING THROUGH A THIRD PERSON).
