STATEMENT (continued) in the matter of: Gregory Joseph SUTTON Sexual Assaults

6. Shortly after the accused was arrested I received a telephone call from a Mr **REDAC**, a resident of the Liverpool area in Sydney. I spoke with this gentleman and later contacted Detective Senior Constable LAWRENCE of the Macquarie Fields Police Station. I am aware that as a result of this telephone call, a number of further matters were revived and forwarded through the Federal Attorney General for extradition proceedings involving the accused.

7. Shortly after 8.30pm ^{when?} I was at the Sydney International Airport with Detective LAWRENCE. I saw the accused enter the terminal in the company of two United States Marshals. I spoke briefly with Marvin LUTZE, Chief Deputy United States Marshal, Eastern District of Missouri.

8. I then said to the accused, " Mr SUTTON, I am Detective Sergeant MAGANN and this is Detective LAWRENCE. We are from the New South Wales Police and have carriage of the allegation made against you. Do you understand that?" He said, " Yes." I said, " What will occur is that you will be taken now through customs and then driven to the Sydney Police Centre. At the Police Centre I will speak with you further about the allegations and give you the opportunity of answering questions about the matters if you wish. Do you understand that?" He said, " Yes."

9. Later at the Sydney Police Centre I said to the accused, " Mr SUTTON what I intend to do is ask you a number of questions about the allegations, before I do I want you to understand that you are not obliged to say anything unless you wish to do so. Do you understand that?" He said, " No not really should I
