**Notice under Clause 5A of the *Child Protection (Working with Children) Regulation 2013***

The Office of the Children's Guardian is responsible for administering the Working With Children Check in NSW and ensuring that employers and workers meet their obligations under the *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012* (the Act) and the *Child Protection (Working with Children) Regulation 2013* (the Regulation).

Further to your e-mail received 14 August 2014, I am aware you currently hold a self-employed persons certificate; number 9EA87E/31/10/2012 which expires on 31/10/2015.

However, Clause 5A of Schedule 1 to the Regulation enables the Children's Guardian to issue of a Notice to the holder of a valid self-employed certificate requiring the holder not to engage in child-related work unless the worker holds a Working with Children Check clearance or has a current application for a clearance. ( section 8 of the Act)

If you are currently engaged in child-related work you must apply for a new WWCC by close of business 3 August 2015.

A maximum penalty of \$11,000 and/or imprisonment for 2 years applies for non-compliance with section 8. Copies of clause 5A and section 8 are included with this notice.
