Thank you Mr Callaghan for your quick response.

The Working with Children Check (WWCC) changed in June 2013 and while existing CSEP "certificates" were honoured they now no longer exist. The new WWCC has no paper, just a number is provided. Application is made online and identity proven at an RMS (old RTA).

You would need to apply for the new WWCC before you work with children in NSW, if that is what you intend to do.

When a worker applies and is cleared, they receive a WWC number. They show this number to whoever employs them. Employers are legally required to verify this WWC number online through their employer registration.
