Please find following information received from Tennis NSW in relation to criminal charges being placed upon the NSWIS Tennis Head Coach, Noel Callaghan.

Please note from the official statement that the alleged events took place long before Noel's association with Tennis NSW, and NSWIS.

Noel has stood down from his position as Head Coach to concentrate on defending these charges. In the interim John Ireland, a former touring professional and Level 2 coach, will be taking the responsibility for the program.

The NSWIS will be making no further comment on the situation until legal proceedings have been completed.
