My dear Minister,

Last week when I visited Brewarrina I met with Mr. Bert Gordon who, together with his wife, operates the Bethcar Aboriginal Children's Home, at Brewarrina.

Mr. and Mrs. Gordon's unselfish efforts in providing a foster home for disadvantaged aboriginal children is well known to your Department and at present they are operating the Home, which presently accommodates 21 children, on just \$94.50 per week from the State Government.

I understand that approximately one month ago the Director of your Department, Mr. W. Langshaw, visited the Bethcar Home and indicated that action would be taken to provide an additional amount to the Home, for which it was eligible.

As the plight of the Home is becoming rather desperate, I would very much appreciate it if urgent action could be taken for this money to be made available to the Home.
