QUESTIONS TO BE ASKED OF ACCEPTABLE PERSON WHERE BAIL IS GRANTED

In respect of all cases where an acceptable person is required, either to enter an acknowledgement, an undertaking without security or an undertaking with security, the following questions should be asked:

Q.1. Please produce evidence as to your identity and your place of abode. (The Justice should note what evidence is produced and record details)

Q.2. How long have you known the accused person?

7 years.

Q.3. What is your relationship with the accused person?
(e.g. relative, de facto, employer/employee, friend, etc.)

Friend

Q.4. Have you had any criminal convictions in the last 5 years?
If so, for what?

No.

Further questions should be asked where the acceptable person agrees to forfeit money or security if the accused person fails to comply with the undertaking (Section 36(2)(d)).

Q.5. What financial resources do you have from which you will be able to pay this money should the accused person fail to comply with the bail undertaking? (The justice should obtain evidence of this and record details).


Q.7. Where did you obtain the money/security? Please produce evidence of your ownership of the money/security. (The justice should record details).
