

FIRST ELECTION REPORT – ^{CDM} [REDACTED] **(201106861)**

Matter number 201106861 is the third current matter for ^{CDM} [REDACTED]. The ODPP has already elected in relation to matters one (201016539) and two (201015523).

At the time of all offences the accused was working at a child care centre; and all three matters arise from disclosures of aggravated indecent assaults made by young girls attending the centre.

I have attached the previous election report re: complainants ^{CEW} [REDACTED] and ^{CEY} [REDACTED]. I have also attached a consolidated version of the facts.

The present matter involves complainant ^{CDO} [REDACTED], ^{CDO} [REDACTED], age 4, discloses the accused kissed her on the lips while she was at the child care centre (s61M(2)).

Prima facie this matter is less serious than the previous matters. In my view it falls at the lower end of the scale. However, given the multiple complainants (prospects of a joint trial using T&C evidence), the eight year SNPP applicable to s61M(2), and the significant breach of trust, it is submitted the Local Court would not have sufficient sentencing scope.

I recommend an election be made.
