I acknowledge receipt of your letter of 28 May 2102 requesting the removal of all conditions from your service approval (licence).

Your request was made on the basis that the Director of Public Prosecutions had directed that there be no further proceedings in relation to the charges that had been brought against ^{CDM} [REDACTED] who is your father, and at the time a staff member at ^{CEG} [REDACTED] (the service”).

You have advised the Department that ^{CDM} [REDACTED] does not wish to resume his role as the cook at the service but that he wishes to return to his maintenance role to enable him to conduct maintenance on the building and premises outside the services operating hours.
