CONVICTED

As to **Count 2** sentenced to imprisonment for one year to date from 10 December 2009 and to expire 9 December 2010

As to **Count 1** sentenced to imprisonment for five years to date from 10 December 2009 and to expire 9 December 2014

As to **Counts 3 and 4** sentenced to imprisonment for five years to date from 10 December 2010 and to expire 9 December 2015

As to **Counts 6, 7, 8 and 9** sentenced to imprisonment for three years to date from 10 December 2011 and expire 9 December 2014

My reason for not setting parole periods is the structure of the sentences makes it inappropriate to do so.

As to **Counts 5 and 10** I set a non-parole period of three years and a balance of term of ³ ~~two~~ years. *pk.*

The non-parole period is to commence on 10 December 2012 and will expire on 9 December 2015 which, subject to the next sentences, is the earliest date on which the offender will be eligible to be released on parole. (BZY Indictment)

As to **Counts 1, 2 and 4** sentenced to imprisonment for three years to date from 10 December 2012 and to expire 9 December 2015

As to **Counts 5 and 6** sentenced to imprisonment for four years to date from 10 December 2012 and to expire 9 December 2016

My reason for not setting parole periods is the structure of the sentences makes it inappropriate to do so.

As to **Counts 3 and 7** I set a non-parole period of four years and a balance of term of two years.

The non-parole period is to commence on 10 December 2012 and will expire on 9 December 2016 which, subject to the next sentence, is the earliest date on which the offender will be eligible to be released on parole.

As to **Count 8** I set a non-parole period of four years and a balance of term of four years.

The non-parole period is to commence on 10 December 2012 and will expire on 9 December 2016 which is the earliest date on which the offender will be eligible to be released on parole.

Effective overall non-parole period, including Judge Latham's sentence is a non-parole period of 12 years with a balance of term of 4 years – total term of imprisonment 16 years
