The letter is requesting Tennis NSW's legal representative to provide NSWIS with a copy of the transcript of the interview with the player who has made the allegations against the coach. When previously requested to provide this information to our legal representative, Tennis NSW's Legal Adviser refused the request. In addition to this Colin Love has also expressed concern that the coach in question is still being allowed to coach NSWIS scholarship holders whilst these allegations are being investigated by their Legal Adviser. Tennis NSW believe that since the coach will be supervised in all instances whilst coaching then he still should be allowed to coach while the investigation occurs.

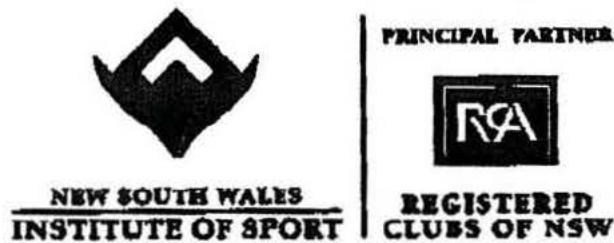
