I spoke to Colonel Peterson to-day by phone and acquainted him with the incidents covered in the Henderson's report.

He was aware of the abscondings but was not aware of the excessive punishment meted out.

The details were relayed to him and he was informed of the Dept's concern ^{about} the degree of the punishment. I also made it clear that the District Officer was in a large way responsible for the restoration of order in the home.

Colonel Peterson intends to visit Gaulhorn shortly and will have words with Major Reddell about this matter. He assured me that this type of action is not typical of Major Reddell and there would be no recurrence.
