These letters were handed in at the office shortly after Mr. Wilson received an official reprimand for assaulting an inmate **REDACTED** and presumably this had some bearing on their decision although Mr. Wilson has spoken of leaving the service for some considerable time.

It will be noted that Mr. & Mrs. Wilson wish to cease duty on 20th February, 1966.
