SUBJECT: Suspension from duty.

Following enquiries into your conduct as Deputy Superintendent, Training School for Girls, Parramatta, you are hereby suspended from duty on the following charges:-

That you were guilty of disgraceful or improper conduct within the meaning of Section 56^(h) of the Public Service Act, 1902, as amended, in that

- (1) whilst **QQ** was an inmate of the Training School for Girls, Parramatta, between 10th April, 1959, and 1st October, 1959, you failed to exercise proper control and discipline towards the said inmate.
- (2) since the said inmate's discharge on 1st October, 1959, you did improperly associate with the said **QQ**
- (3) on the 26th January, 1961, at the Long Bay Prison under the false name of Eric **REDACTE** you went surety for the appearance of **QQ** **QQ** at the Sydney Court of Quarter Sessions to be held on 1st February, 1961.
- (4) you persuaded an employee of the Department Mrs. Mary Ryan to act contrary to Departmental policy in accommodating **QQ** in her home.
