We would like to take the opportunity to thank you and your husband for meeting with us today. We appreciated your feedback and viewpoint regarding your daughter CDO's safety and wellbeing and acknowledge that this is an extremely difficult time for you and your family.

We would like to acknowledge that communication between the three agency's that comprise the Joint Investigation Response Team and your family has not been as effective as it should have been and recognize that this appears to have caused you confusion and anxiety.

Following our meeting we would like to confirm that from a Community Services perspective we will be recording on our database that CDO has attended a child care centre where she has been placed at substantiated risk of harm. Community Services is unable to confirm to the level of proof that we require to state categorically that she has experienced harm based on the evidence that we currently have.

In order to ensure that CDO has access to counselling services Community Services has agreed to 'raise a belief' in relation to harm based upon her substantiated risk of harm and the additional concerns that you have raised.

I have liaised with the clinical co-ordinator at the CPU and relayed some of your concerns. They have advised me that they will review the matter. As this is a NSW Health Service I have requested that they liaise with your family directly about this.

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In order to ensure that you are provided with consistency I would invite you to contact A/MCW Gemma Millar upon her return from leave on 2 August 2011 if you wish to discuss this matter further. As advised today, Sgt Maloney will available for you to contact in the interim.
