Dear CDP

Kogarah Joint Investigation Response Team (JIRT) is a combined service, comprising of NSW Police, Community Services and Health.

Kogarah JIRT received a report in February 2011 regarding your daughter being the victim of a sexual/indecent assault.

Your daughter was interviewed on 09 February 2011 and disclosed details of the sexual/indecent assault by the person causing harm (PCH), which have been noted and confirmed on the Community Services database. NSW Police are continuing with the case against the PCH. As your daughter has been deemed safe, well cared for and protected in you and your family's care, there is no further role for NSW Community Services in relation to this matter.

Based on this, Kogarah JIRT Community and Family Services will now be closing the matter for your daughter. The Police OIC Detective Senior Constable Kelly Donaghy is still able to be contacted in relation to any issues surrounding the ongoing case against the PCH.

We would encourage you to continue to support your daughter over the foreseeable future and continue to support her attendance at counselling for as long as it is deemed necessary by the counsellor.
