MCW Lisa de Meur and CPCW Margy Jones met with Detective Constable Kim Duncombe from Burwood Police Station 9745 8484 to discuss case and appropriate action to take.

It was agreed that Kim and her partner Nicole would follow up matters to see if a criminal conviction was an option.

I rang Working With Children Checks 9286 7219. They advised that these checks are only relevant for employees which means that the POI in this case will not come up with anything. The only other way he can come up is through Prohibited Employment Check if he has been previously criminally convicted. The commission is aware of this is gap in the system in relation to people like this and is hoping to change legislation in the next six months.

At this stage no casework will be taken until further direction from police when they have finished taking official statements.
