DETAILS OF INCIDENT:

1. Child attends Mater Dei School, Camden as a boarder.
2. On the weekend of 25-26 May whilst visiting the mountains mother observed bleeding after ^{CIB} had been to the toilet.
3. Child taken to Nepean Hospital where an ulcer in the bowl was diagnosed.
4. When mother returned home with daughter she visited her local G.P. who stated that ulcer was result of sexual abuse.
5. Mother firmly believes her daughter was sexually assaulted whilst at the school and has removed her from that school.
6. ^{CIC} feels a house parent named ^{CID} is responsible for alleged injury.
7. It is understood the school has since terminated ^{CID} 's employment.

PROPOSED ACTION:

1. Police to be informed.
2. Mother to be contacted and arrangements made to interview both parent and daughter.

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3. As ^{CIB} is intellectually handicapped and as this Unit does not have a District Officer, Disability Services, arrangements to be made for an officer from D.D.Services, Kogarah to be present during interview.
4. Liaise with Principal, Mater Dei School re the dismissal of house parent ^{CID}.
5. Case to be allocated to District Officer Isabel Stepanik priority 1.
6. A Section 23 Certificate to be issued on parent so that a medical examination at a Specialist Unit (Prince of Wales Hospital) can be carried out, as there appears to be conflict of medical opinion between the examining doctor at the Nepean Hospital and the general practitioner.
