CIE 15 years suffers from autism. On Tuesday 20 March 2012 CIE returned from respite and was upset and told REDACTED that his respite care Royce COMBER from Disability Trust had touched his willy in the toilets. When the REDACTED questioned him, CIE said that it had happened many times. He said that he hadn't told anyone because he thought it was his fault and he was aroused. CIE went on to say that Royce had been bullying him into saying that he was a homosexual. CIE said that Royce had been saying that he wanted to be his friend and wanted to be in a sexual relationship with him.

CIE has been going to respite with Disability Trust for many years. He has had contact with Royce for approximately one year. The respite occurs once a week for three hours with different carers, CIE and the carer participate in different activities. On Tuesday 20 March 2012 CIE and Royce had been bike riding together – they left at 15:30 and returned at 16:30 which was unusual because they are usually gone longer than that.



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CIE does not verbally communicate. He needs to use QWERTY (a computer board) where he types things.

CIE, REDACTED, reported the matter to police on Wednesday morning 21 March 2012. REDACTED have also advised Disability Trust of their allegations and have withdrawn CIE from the service.

Royce has no prior history on the police COPS system relating to child sexual offences or any other offences involving children.

The reporter gave consent for their identifying information to be given to NSW Health and NSW Police.

SCRPT Rationale:

This current report is a multiple as the same concerns have already been reported on 21/3/2012. A < 10 day report has already been referred to JRJ and an allegation report has also been completed.

Nil legal records, CWU events and alerts

One other report dated 28/4/2008 - < 10 days states that CIE has severe autism and a possible intellectual delay and was exhibiting deteriorating/violent behaviours at home and at school. In response to this, the mother was using excessive physical discipline.
