
2. I am 50 years of age. I was born on REDACTED 1950.

3. I am the Headmaster of Trinity Grammar School, Summer Hill Campus, Strathfield Campus and Pine Bluff Campus. Trinity Grammar is situated at Prospect Road, Summer Hill. I have held that position since July, 1996. My responsibilities as Headmaster is the overall management and conduct of the school through to The School Council.

4. On the 11 August, 2000 I was approached by the Senior Master Mr Peter GREEN who informed me of investigations into an incident in the boarding house undertaken by himself and the Senior Boarding House Master, Robert SCOTT.

5. It is general practice for students involved in an incident to complete an incident report giving their version of what took place. I don't recall whether I read any incidents reports on this particular incident.

6. I can recall that the boys names involved in the incident were CLA, REDACTED and CLB. Mr GREEN and I agreed that suspension was an appropriate option given the circumstances as we knew them. The matter was then to be followed up by the Boarding House Master in relation to the suspension of the boys from the Boarding House and the counsellor Kate PEARCE.

7. On the 7 September, 2000 there was a meeting held in my office where Kate PEARCE brought to my attention further revelations in relation to the incident. I can recall during this meeting viewing and discussing a memo created by Kate PEARCE. We also referred to a number of statements completed by the students. A decision was made that The Department of Community Services should be notified which took place on the same day. This was done by telephone and by mail.

8. I have been requested by Detective CUTHBERTSON to supply a confirmation of a discontinuation of enrolment letter for REDACTED REDACT. Records indicate is education at the School ceased at the end of Trinity Term 8 September, 2000.
