If she raises the article herself, try and gauge her reaction. I am just concerned that we ensure if there are any negative reactions to last week by Carmen (and AJE and AJD) we try and work through them now rather than let them fester.

Thanks for your help last week. I think we have assembled a good team on what will be an important trial.
