Monitor response assessment –

School 1 has informed NSWPF about allegations.

They have advised the information was valuable, but could not confirm or deny whether or not SOA was a person of interest. NSWPF noted that they can not take any further action as they have not received a formal complaint from any person against SOA.

NSWPF contacted the member of staff at School 1 who had first reported the rumour about SOA and noted that the source of the rumour was a former staff member at Knox (Mr or Mrs REDACT).

HOA contacted Mr Peter Crawley – the former Headmaster of Knox at the time SOA left that school – who reported he negotiated SOA leaving Knox as he had not heeded direction he received on 3 separate occasions to cease taking photographs of boys in their swimming costumes. Mr PC was fearful SOA was grooming the boys and wanted the behaviour to stop. When it didn't, SOA was removed from the school. Knox did not report this to the OO at that time. HOA informed NSWPF of this info on 23/3/09.

NSWPF has requested School 1 not to investigate the matter at this time so as not to jeopardise any criminal investigation.

Updated risk assessment – SOA low risk. No longer coaching water polo. No concerns and CCYP check was clear.

Action:

- Advise AB of the info
- Request update on NSWPF investigation in 6 weeks time.
