Dear Peter

I have spoken to my solicitor and he finds the wording of the reconciliation letter acceptable. There are three other issues, which rise out of it, which still need to be addressed.

The first is the question of what else remains on my record. Is there anything else on my record that is either negative or which might be interpreted as a disciplinary matter? I refer specifically to the rumours that were raised with me last year. Is there any official record of them?

Rising from that, I am assuming that what is on my record might inform your response to any potential future employer who rings for your input. I would like to know what would be the substance of your reply.

The third is the matter of my legal fees. As the original letter I received from you has now been withdrawn and many of the assumptions that underpinned it have proven to be false, I believe that I am in a strong position to request that the school meet my legal costs. These amounted to \$1,750 by the end of June.

I would be more than happy to discuss any of these issues with you.
