

CONFIDENTIAL**NOTES ON** [REDACTED]**A. DRIVING BOY FROM FOOTBALL PRACTICE**

1. Late in May 1999 during the football season [REDACTED] was seen wrestling with [REDACTED] and pushing on the boy's stomach with his foot. This was noted by several of the coaches who were not impressed by [REDACTED]'s behaviour, but did not report it at that time.
2. At the end of Term 2 in 1999, in fact the last Monday of the Term, in Gillespie Fields [REDACTED] stood chatting at the entrance to Gillespie for 40 minutes to [REDACTED]. The boy was supposed to be at practice with the other boys and remained with [REDACTED] until his coach, Chris Weber, told [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] was required for practice, then [REDACTED] left.
3. Term 2 1999, at Curagul [REDACTED] was told to go by bus with the rest of the boys and this instruction was repeated to him as he was going towards [REDACTED]'s car. Chris Weber said "please go on the bus". In the following few minutes [REDACTED] again invited [REDACTED] to his car and offered him a lift. [REDACTED] drove [REDACTED] from Curagul, I assume, back to school.
4. Mid Term 3 [REDACTED] again was given a lift by [REDACTED] from practice at Curagul. It appears that there may have been more than two occasions when [REDACTED] drove [REDACTED] from football practice rather than [REDACTED] returning with the rest of the boys on the bus provided.

B. TOUCHING

I spoke to [REDACTED] informally, on two occasions mid last year about his communication style of touching boys, or patting them as he spoke with them. I pointed out it was too intimate and personal and could be misunderstood. I raised this issue more formally in [REDACTED]'s review late last year, documentation of this is available.

C. PHOTOGRAPHS

On at least one occasion early last year I advised [REDACTED] verbally not to take photographs of the boys at the swimming pool. Comments were made to me by PE staff that he was "always hanging around the pool taking photographs". I told him that his action could be seen as provocative and misunderstood.

He seemed willing to accept this advice. However, I noticed at Inter House swimming early this year he was again taking photographs. He said it was only boys in his House although I cannot verify this.

He again was taking photographs in the team enclosure at the CAS swimming carnival. It appears he did not take my advice.
