Please find enclosed notes compiled by myself concerning charges laid against [redacted] in relationship to AYC.

It is advised that Maxwell Ronald Gleeson appeared in the Children's Court on the 29th June and was charged with unlawfully and indecently dealing with AYC. This hearing was adjourned to 10 a.m. on the 6th July and again adjourned to 10 a.m. on the 7th July owing to the unavoidable absence of Dr. Rees, Government Medical Officer. The defendant pleaded 'not guilty' to this charge and reserved his defence. The Magistrate decided that a prima facie case was proved against the defendant and committed him for trial at the sittings of the District Court, Rockhampton, commencing on the 16th August, 1966. The defendant applied for bail which was refused. The defendant has also applied for legal aid.

The defendant was remanded in the custody of the Police and will be escorted to Brisbane with the first available Police escort for detention at Westbrook.

As stated at the commencement of this letter, Maxwell Gleeson is a probationer with this Department. He is a most unsatisfactory probationer and this will be the third time he has been charged with this offence.
