Hi, Wayne. Summary to date on the status of Scott's Blue Card application is as follows:

- Scott's Blue Card Application Form was initially posted on 5 March 2009.
- Commission acknowledged application was received on 6 March 2009.
- A request for further information was sent by the Commission to Scott on 12 April 2009.
- Scott returned this information on approximately 15 April 2009.
- My first contact with the Commission for a status update was on 12 May 2009 (Jo). I was advised the application was still being processed and as a request for further information had been sent out, this would take a further 28 days from when they received the requested information for processing. No further information on the application's status was available on that day.

- My second contact with the Commission for a status update was on 25 May 2009 (Jess). I was given the same spiel: that the application was still being processed by an external agency and to ring back in a week or so. Despite all my manoeuvrings, the most I could achieve was that a Supervisor would ring me.
- As no phone call was received from the aforesaid Supervisor, my third contact with the Commission for a status update was on 27 May 2009. I once again spoke with the original person, Jo, who was far more helpful and put me through to her Supervisor. The Supervisor was in fact Adam from the Legal Department of the Commission. He apologised for our difficulties with obtaining information and also apologised that I had been given incorrect information about the 28 days. He said that the 28 days was in fact 28 working days, and this timeframe only applied to straight-forward applications, whereas Scott's was more complex and would take longer than this.

He confirmed that all the legislative requirements had been satisfied, all the information was to hand, and the application is awaiting final assessment. He indicated that they worked with the police with the processing of applications, so I can only assume that the 'external agency' that is doing this final assessment is the Qld Police.

He invited me to call back as often as I wanted to check on the status – daily, if required – and that I could ask to speak to him directly. He also said that he would be talking to the person doing the assessment and that he would pass on any further information if it was available.
