ORDER OF MENTAL HEALTH TRIBUNAL

THE MATTER of the mental condition of Reginald Basil DURHAM a person charged with an indictable offence namely rape, indecent dealing(21) liable to be detained and *detained in/residing at 7A Phyllis Street Rockhampton Qld having been referred to the Mental Health Tribunal by L.J. Clare, Director of Public Prosecutions

AND the reference having been heard by the tribunal on the 21st day of February 2001

AND the Tribunal HAVING FOUND that the said Reginald Basil DURHAM

- * ~~was suffering from unsoundness of mind at the time the alleged offence was committed,~~
- * was not suffering from unsoundness of mind at the time the alleged offence was committed and is not fit for trial,

ORDERS that the said Reginald Basil DURHAM be detained as a restricted patient under Part IV of the *Mental Health Act 1974* in-

- * ~~a security patient's hospital namely-~~
- * another hospital namely Rockhampton Base Hospital but that he be granted leave on conditions as attached
