Sir,

With reference to the recent outbreak of typhoid fever at the Meteor Park Orphanage, I have the honour to advise that on visiting the Institution, the Sister in Charge of the Infirmary reported that same was nearly stamped out. They only had three cases remaining and they were not considered to be of a serious nature. They attributed the cause of the outbreak to the admission of a child from REDACTED, and who is not yet a State Child, although they are not perfectly sure on this point. The child in question is one named REDACTED, papers in connection with whom, were recently forwarded you.
