The applicant said that he only received our suspension letter today, and the due date to return his blue card is today. The applicant said that he has already returned his blue card to the Ayr Police Station on 24/09/14 and he has a receipt (receipt number: S431256). I said that we would follow up with the police to have the blue card returned to us.

The applicant said that he would think about it, however he would probably send in the form. The applicant asked if there was a timeframe on returning the form and I said no.
