You may have heard that our children's home in Darwin, the Retta Dixon Home, is concluding its ministry of looking after children on 30 June. The Home first commenced at the request of the Government after World Warr II and over the years many many children have been cared for by devoted Christian House Parents.

Government policy regarding the care of such children has changed. Children are now being placed in foster homes and so the need for such a home as the Retta Dixon Home has not only diminished greatly over the past months, but will now cease.

We have been thankful for the devotion and love that Norman and Lola Wall have been able to give to children in their care over the past 8 years.

You will rejoice with us to know that they are going to continue to occupy the cottage on the Retta Dixon Home site and will foster children on behalf of the Northern Territory Government.

On their behalf we would like to express to you our sincere thanks for all the help and assistance you have given them over the years, and would ask that you continue to uphold them in prayer in the task that will be theirs in continuing the oversight of children in their care.
