- Question 12. *Have you carefully read, and do you cordially approve of the Principles and Practices of the A.I.M.?*
- Question 13. *Are your parents living? If so, give their name and address.*
- Question 14. *Are they, or any other relatives, dependent upon you for support?*
- Question 15. (a) *Do your parents consent to you taking this step?*
(b) *If not, what is their objection?*
- Question 16. *What is your profession, trade or occupation?*
- Question 17. *If in any employment, please state—*
(a) *Name and address of your present employer;*
(b) *How long have you been with him?;*
(c) *Name and address of your previous employer, if any.*

- Question 18. Have you any objection to application being made to them for references as to character? (No such application will be made without your consent.)*
- Question 19. Are you liable for any debts?*
- Question 20. What educational advantages have you had?*
- Question 21. (a) Give a short list of books you have read. Underline one or more that you have studied particularly.*
(b) What Periodicals do you usually read?
- Question 22. Give names and addresses of two or three Christian friends who would be willing to answer enquiries concerning you, stating their position, business, or occupation. One of these should, if possible, be your Minister.*
- Question 23. If accepted as a Probationary Missionary you will be required to sign a declaration that you are prepared to conform to the principles of the A.I.M. and abide by the counsel and direction of those in authority, and are prepared to trust God for the supply of all your needs. Do you assent to this?*
