

The Commissioner of Police met with Archbishop Wilson in March 2002 regarding allegations of improper conduct by a previous employee of the church.

The allegations related to conduct a number of years ago and at that time a police investigation was undertaken resulting in the arrest of a person.

That person failed to appear to answer the charges.

A warrant of apprehension was subsequently issued which to date has not been executed, and the matter is still before the Court.

As a result of the meeting with the Archbishop, police are reviewing the initial investigation and will also respond to any further information provided as a result of the Archbishop's advice to the media and other sections of the community.
