LX usually went to school in a bus driven by Eugene but Brian picked him up on numerous occasions when Eugene was unavailable. Brian was usually the driver on school camps and excursions.

Prior to attending St Ann's LX was a placid, good natured, compliant child, friendly and outgoing. This changed in a short time once he attended St Ann's. Family, friends and the school all commented on the change in his behaviour as outlined in the statement.

The effects of this is not only restricted to LX but to his siblings (two younger brothers now 17 and 15), his parents and the family life style. A recent example of how this has impinged on the family is that they had book a family holiday with LX going into respite but could not proceed because of their raised fears and anxieties.

REDACTED know they need some support and so do the younger sons.

LX needs expert help to address all the problems that have developed since attending St Ann's.
