Dear NE

I have heard from Peter Mulhearn that things are progressing slowly but surely with LH's assessment and counselling.

I understand from Peter that your husband is now back from overseas and is being very supportive of LH. He is a very fortunate lad to have such capable and caring foster parents.

NE, I have just been transferred to another office and so LH's case will be looked after by someone else from now on. I have written up a report for the Child Protection Panel about LH's unfortunate experience, and have said that he is well supported in his foster placement, and is to have counselling re his sexuality with REDA REDAC. I have also mentioned in my report that at LH's wish, his parents have not been informed. It may be that this needs to be discussed again with LH a bit further down the track.

If you want to contact Family & Community Services about LH in the next week or so, I suggest you ask to speak to the manager of Adelaide Office, Maureen Healey (phone REDACT). Goodwood Office area will be looked after from Adelaide Office in the near future. Lam at this stage is still MA's case worker.
