Subject: Extradition of Brian Bertram Morris PERKINS from Queensland.

1. In 1993 as a result of 'Operation Deny' Brian Bertram Morris PERKINS, and others, were arrested and charged with sexual offences against children. He was released on court bail and absconded. On 21/1/94 a warrant to apprehend (indictable offence) was issued at the Adelaide Magistrate's Court for the arrest of PERKINS for the offence of incite or procure an indecent act by a child to gratify a prurient interest (Section 58A(1)(A) of the C.I.C.A.).
2. As a result of enquiries I have conducted to locate PERKINS I have established that he is living at the Inkerman Caravan Park, Bruce Highway, INKERMAN via HOME HILL, QUEENSLAND. This has been confirmed by Detective Senior Constable Gavin NEAL of AYR C.I.B., telephone 0747835888. Ayr C.I.B. is responsible for the area where PERKINS is living.
3. As a warrant is in existence for the arrest of PERKINS could enquiries be made as to whether approval will be given for the extradition of PERKINS from Queensland to South Australia. Detective NEAL has been advised that no approval has been given for extradition at this time and he will not approach PERKINS until I get back to him with the decision as to extradition going ahead or not.
4. Detective S/C Lenny MOSHEEV (now) of Adelaide C.I.B. was the arresting officer in the matter of PERKINS. I would be willing to attend to the extradition of PERKINS if MOSHEEV does not want to, or is unable to go to Queensland.
5. I am on a P.D.O. on Monday 23/2/97 and then 4 R.D.O.'s, but I would be able to change my roster to work dayshift on Thursday/Friday of this week if the need arose to attend Queensland. From Saturday 28/2/98 I am on dayshift until 6/3/98.
