- Appointment of a permanent task force to investigate historical sexual offences;
- A policy review to establish a coporate protocol for the interviewing and presentation of evidence by intellectually impaired persons; and
- A review of the existing JIS linkage between DPP and SAPOL in respect of amending and altering warrants; I am aware that the failings in accuracy on the JIS has led to a number of civil claims (particularly unlawful arrest) and so I would be particularly interested in having this aspect pursued from a need to protect SAPOL's corporate liability.

I have had the report for some time I'm afraid – with a view to assessing what information should be given to the Crown Solicitor in relation to a potential civil claim by the parents. This file only has the Post Operational Assessment and does not contain any of the referring/source documentation.

I suspect that if the criminal case has been finalised, the civil action (if it is to proceed) will pick up momentum. I will tentatively raise the state of play with Michael Mills Assistant Crown Solicitor (from whom I have received no further follow up on this case since August 2002), who has the instructions to co-ordinate a whole of government response in relation to the allegations of negligence.

I will be happy to return the file for your consideration in the interim if required. Apologies for the delay due to other competing commitments,
