Re: GLENCROSS, HAWKES & PERKINS

The matter of Glencross, Hawkes and Perkins came before the Adelaide Magistrates Court on the 16th the December 1993. So that information could be laid the matter was adjourned until the 21st of January 1994. I attach to the minute of copy of the letter sent to Mick Harper of Adelaide Prosecutions outlining the informations which will be laid and which declarations we will refer to which information.

Please note that there is a time limit for which the information must be laid and all declarations must be filed.

This means that all declarations must be filed and served on defence counsel by Christmas Eve, the 24th of December 1993.

In this regard I note there are no declarations concerning Perkins. Declarations should be compiled and forwarded to my office forthwith. This include the seizing of the items from Perkins' residence and all attempts which have been made to interview Perkins. No declaration is to be filed concerning the complainant, LH [REDACTED]. An application will be made for LH [REDACTED] to be called at the committal to give oral evidence.

Declarations need to be obtained and signed by David Kellett and also Vicki Sherlock (chain of evidence).

You will note that no charges have been laid where the complainant is [REDACTED]. After careful consideration of the evidence and what has transpired between Glencross and [REDACTED] I am of the opinion that no prosecution should proceed with respect to [REDACTED].

As concerns [REDACTED] a charge has been laid at this stage, but this is subject to finding photographs of [REDACTED]. Please liaise with each other to ascertain whether there are any photographs of [REDACTED]. If so, declarations as those photographs need to be compiled and forwarded to my office immediately. You should ensure that [REDACTED] identifies those photographs as well as his mother.

Further work to be done before 21st January 1994:-

To assist us with prosecuting this matter effectively all investigating officers are asked to compile a brief concerning the victims that they are the investigating officer for. This brief should include a summary of the facts and the evidence against each accused. Please ensure that all chain evidence has been obtained and declarations from the people involved have been signed and forwarded to my office. This concerns chain evidence of the letters which were seized from England and the seizing of all photographs.

Please ensure that each victim can clearly identify the accused who has either sexually interfered with them or taken photos of them. Each victim should also be able to identify the photographs of them.

Finally, before the next court date it will imperative that we have copies of all photographs on which we intend to rely (namely those photographs referred to in the declarations) and all letters. Please obtain two further copies of these exhibits which are unmarked.

As of January 1994 Patricia Kelly of my office will be placed at the Adelaide Police Prosecutions and will be conducting the court hearings in this matter. However, if you have any queries you are to contact Ms Thomas of my office.

I thank you for your assistance to date and look forward to hearing from you in the next couple of days.
