Can you please clarify what "course of conduct" your client is prepared to admit. For example, is your client prepared to admit the "course of conduct" encompassing:

- (i) the indecent assaults at his flat (touching LH [REDACTED] penis - p3 - 6 of Interview 28/1/94);
- (ii) the indecent assaults at his flat (rubbing LH [REDACTED] with oil and LH [REDACTED] rubbing his penis with oil - pp 17-18 of Interview 28/1/94)
- (iii) the fellatio (p25-27; 37 of Interview 28/1/94)
- (iv) indecent assaults at school (pp 2 - 10 Interview 15/4/02).

In relation to count 6, I have been advised that MR [REDACTED] is intellectually disabled to the extent of not being able to give a statement to the police. He is identified from the video tape as MR [REDACTED] in the declaration of Bernard Farrington dated 24/7/02, however, I can also obtain a statement from his carers/school teachers at the time.
