RE: BRIAN PERKINS

I refer to our discussions.

I note that your Information contains a major indictable count. I am instructed that count 5 is denied. *- and of course*

However, I am instructed by Mr Perkins that he wishes in the circumstances to resolve these charges in the most expeditious manner. Amongst other things, one needs to take into account his age, and state of health, as noted by Dr McCleave in the enclosed report. Mr Perkins wishes to avoid a protracted trial and also wishes to avoid any further distress and embarrassment to the Complainants.

In the circumstances, I am instructed by Mr Perkins that he is prepared to plead guilty to a course of conduct that encompasses counts 1,2,3 and 4 on the basis that the matter can be finalised in a court of summary jurisdiction. *gratify prosecutor interest (and) indecent assault*

I am in the process of taking instructions with respect to count 6 but do not believe that I am in possession of a statement of MR REDACTED. Count 6 was recently added. In the event that a statement supports the allegation, Mr Perkins would plead guilty. *indecent assault.*

In the circumstances, are you prepared to accept pleas of guilty to minor indictable charges to be determined in the Magistrates' Court in satisfaction of the Information as laid. This offer presumes that you are not contemplating any further charges based on material you already have to hand.
