RE: HAWKES, GLENCROSS and PERKINS

Attendance at the Adelaide Magistrates Court on Friday 21st January 1994.

Both matters remanded to the 21st of February 1994. The DPP gives an undertaking to have a statement or audio visual record of interview conforming to the requirements of the Summary Procedure Act filed in relation to the alleged victim LH within 2 weeks from the 21st of January 1994.

Bail to continue on same terms and conditions for Hawkes and Glencross. Perkins does not appear and a warrant for his arrest issued forthwith.

On 21st February 1994 special reasons in relation to counts 1 to 3 on the joint information to be argued. Mr. Hawkes advises that he is about to be hospitalised and may be in hospital on the next adjourned date. The DPP advise the court that a further co-offender, Barton - who has already been charged in another court, may be joined on the information with Hawkes in relation to at least counts 3 and 4 of that information.
