which falls into the bottom 2% of the population for his age group. His mental age is therefore equivalent to that of an eight year old child. His language skills i.e. verbal, expressive skills are particularly poor and although he is confident in his attempts to communicate orally, it is difficult to understand him.

His understanding of social and normal behaviour as measured by the comprehension subtest of the WISC (Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children) indicated a scaled score of three on a range of 0 - 19 indicating that his comprehension and understanding of behavioural situations is at the level of a six year old child.

It is well documented that the Formal Operational Intelligence on a higher thinking level is only achieved at the mental ages of approximately 11 - 12 years when a child can hypothesize and understand complex concepts and consequences. LH is only able to think at a concrete level and will therefore never attain the ability to reason abstractly.
