During my recent visit to the Eden Park Boys' School, I felt the lack of a clear cut policy concerning it.

I noticed in the Inspector's Register as far back as 195? Mr JR [illegible] comments about the need for some change in the course study to suit these boys. Mr [illegible] last year, made suggestions concerning the school: The school is still being run as an ordinary school.

I am [illegible] some matters which, I think, need thought and discussion:

- a) The type & age of boys admitted to the home (liaison with the Salvation Army)
- b) Courses of study, particularly for the senior grades.
- c) Selection of head teacher and staff
- d) Possibility of transporting these boys to the Mt Baker Primary School.
- e) Need for new school building if (d) is not desirable
- f) The provision and supply of material, equipment, teaching aides, library books etc. there is neither a school committee nor welfare [illegible].

I found that the head teacher was not well informed on many matters concerning the boys at the home. Closer liaison appears to be desirable so that a better understanding of the boys can be gained.
