Royal Commission

To address the summons, CAT assessment questions have been used as follows:

Sexualised behaviour	
Rating	Descriptor
<input type="checkbox"/> X	Not relevant (e.g., child too young / child has a disability)
<input type="checkbox"/> A	Age appropriate and normal
<input type="checkbox"/> B	Some minor sexualised behaviours, but not significantly impacting functioning
<input type="checkbox"/> C	Moderate sexualised behaviours that affect functioning and which may place the young person or other people at risk (e.g., age-inappropriate displays, attempts to touch others, or 'groping')
<input type="checkbox"/> D	Significant sexual behaviours that place the child or young person, or other children / the carers at risk (e.g., confirmed attempts to assault/rape others, obsession with hardcore pornography, known interactions with sexual offenders)
<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> E	Extreme sexualised behaviour that places other children, the child or adults at immediate risk (e.g., confirmed serious sexual assaults on others, pathological promiscuity or prostitution)

Where from the above image, the mappings to the royal commission request are:

Data on children (under the age of 10) displaying problem sexual behaviours >> **maps to B and C**

children (aged 10 to 18 years) displaying sexually abusive behaviours >> **maps to D**

children (aged 10 to 18 years) who have committed child sex offences >> **maps to E**

In this report we have not grouped up the question responses or excluded others based on age category as implied in the summons question. We have shown all 4 responses for both age categories.

CAT assessments must have been created between '30/Jun/12' and '30/Jun/14'

A child is counted only once in this report i.e. as per their latest CAT assessment record.

5 report tables have been provided:

Gender	-	Gender of client
Age	-	Age is determined by the age of the client at the time the CAT assessment was created. This is calculated as CLIENT_BIRTH_DATE - ASSESSMENT_DATE
ATSI	-	ATSI status of client
Disability (children with)	-	In C3MS disabilities are entered as a health condition. Therefore this table shows the number of children with a health condition. Children can have more than one health condition.
Disability (health condition breakdown)	-	Reports on the same children from above table Disability (children with) with a 'Y' flag with a further breakdown of health conditions. The same child may be counted multiple times.
