TO THE SENIOR PROBATION OFFICER:

I visited Eden Park Boys' Home on 10/8/65 and spoke to the Brigadier.

At the present time there are 49 boys in residence with four supervisors excluding the Brigadier.

The Brigadier assured me that there was no-one within the home who was younger than 7 years.

The home has not changed significantly during the preceding 12 months; it is not known when the next step in the building programme will be commenced.

There is only one State child in the Home at the present time and he was placed by his parents. Because of this there will be regular visitation to the Home for the time being.
