Subject: Behavioural issue - Steve  
Larkins

- ◆ Warwick Bateman faxed report of his discussions with AA
- ◆ WB called: AA is "very believable".
- ◆ Allan Currie called: he met with AA last night, and believes Larkins should be suspended and referred to Police.
- ◆ I advised him to fax me suspension recommendation, and I will action.
- ◆ He should also advise Larkins of his suspension, which will be "until we receive advice otherwise from outside authorities". He should then advise his Regional team to prevent Larkins getting involved "through the back door".
- ◆ I will then send suspension letter.
- ◆ AC faxed suspension request. I actioned via Glen Toyer: **LARKINS SUSPENDED.**
- ◆ I called Naomi Byrnes at CPEA/JIT Newcastle (REDACT). She is on leave and is not returning to CPEA. Spoke with Sue Kimber.
- ◆ CPEA cannot take third party complaint where the victim is over 18, even if it occurred when they were a child. They must report themselves to the Police.
- ◆ I explained the difficulties we have had getting AA to discuss the matter. She referred me to Newcastle Detectives (REDACT).
- ◆ Called Newcastle Detectives: spoke to Det Sgt Wright and gave brief outline of issues.
- ◆ Cannot take third party report; AA must report himself.
- ◆ ~~Called AA at home: he was not home and I left message with his female partner.~~
- ◆ AC called: he has advised Larkins of his suspension and will advise his Regional team tonight.
- ◆ AA called me and I explained the above to him.
- ◆ Asked him if he had a problem calling the Police to report the matter.
- ◆ He advised he had no problem, but was not at home to write the number down.
- ◆ He will call me on Monday to get the number.
