Re: LARKINS STEVEN ANDREW

Message on voicemail on 11/8/03 from applicant stating that I need to speak to Sgt. Denman of Newcastle Police who will discuss with me the fact that the criminal record does not relate to applicant and that applicant is cleared. Applicant stated that Sgt. Denman stated that no paperwork will be sent in relation to this matter.

Information on criminal record with his name appears incorrect. Letters from applicant along with further documentation was sent by Sgt. Denman to Criminal Records Branch. P/c to Criminal Records Branch who reported that as the matter was non-fingerprinted, they are unable to verify if the applicant is the same person. The paperwork has been sent back to the local command for the arresting officer for determination.

P/c to Sgt. Denman – informed Sgt. Denman about the response from Criminal Records Branch. Sgt. Denman states that as no summons issued, no charge or conviction exists, and therefore he had sent paperwork to Criminal Records Branch after discussing matter with them to have the matter removed from the system. Sgt. Denman will speak to Criminal Records Branch and will review all the paperwork and will contact this Officer in relation to whether the matter will be removed from the system.
